ABOUT THE CONSERVATORY

Areas of instruction currently offered are brass, woodwinds, percussion, voice, musical theater, strings, guitar, piano, Musikgarten.

Lessons are available in beginning and experienced levels for children, youth and adults. The level of instruction will be adapted to the students' age and experience.

Calvary Conservatory of Music is a ministry of Calvary Baptist Church with two purposes:

- To encourage teaching and training in the performance skills of music and the related arts
- To provide a convenient place in a wholesome Christian environment for instructors to teach and children to learn

TUITION AND PAYMENT OPTIONS

A non-refundable fee of \$10 is due upon registration each semester. The cost per semester may vary by the length of each instructor's semester and instrument studied. When a student registers for a partial semester, the lesson amounts will be pro-rated.

Lesson times cannot be secured until all paperwork for credit card and ACH payments is received by the Music Office. A parent's signature is required as part of the enrollment process.

Payment for lessons and the registration fee will always be in advance of lessons and may be made in either of the following ways:

- A one-time cash/check/credit card payment for the semester. Please make checks payable to Calvary Baptist Church.
- Four equal Visa/Master Card/Discover payments drawn by the Financial Secretary.
- Authorize the Financial Secretary to initiate four equal debit entries at a specified financial institution. A voided check from the institution is required.
- Payment for the summer semester may be made in advance with two payments as indicated above.

MUSIC FEES

The student will be responsible to the instructor for the cost of music and festival fees.

ABSENCES

The Conservatory does not require instructors to make up lessons missed due to student illness, student school/work requirements or other untimely conflicts.

Instructors who must cancel lessons for any reason will seek to make up the missed lesson at a mutually agreeable time.

In general, the Conservatory will observe the Rapides Parish Public School System calendar. If schools close for an emergency, the Conservatory will close and the instructor will seek to arrange a make-up lesson.

TERMINATION

In the event a student or parent wishes to terminate instruction, a 30-day notice to the Conservatory Office is required. The student or parent will be responsible for classes/lessons that occur within 30 days from the date the notice is given.

FACULTY

All faculty members have a college degree and/or have teaching experience in their field of instruction.
