Here are just a few of the things that have been happening in and through your church at this time:

- We have been busy communicating and providing relief for our widows.
- We have been working hard with city and state entities in the relief effort.
- We have donated and handed out food and water in the last few days in the neighborhood surrounding our church and throughout the city.
- We are preparing 500 meals a day that we deliver to distribution areas at other churches and businesses here in Alexandria and the Hineston area.
- Our Collaborative group has helped local colleges and residents clean up limbs and debris.
- Our students are cooking hamburgers tonight to hand out in the community.
- We will serve as a Red Cross staffing area for the next couple of weeks, providing them a place to stay at night.
- We are a "cooling center" for the elderly who need a place to rest during the heat of the day.
- We've passed out popsicles and frozen treats to kids in places that still didn't have power.
